

#### **APPENDIX 8**

## **Medical Emergency Response**

#### **Purpose**

To ensure provision of Medical Emergency Response (MER) to minimize the potential consequences of workplace injury or acute illness.

#### Who is this for?

Asset Managers, Facilities Manager, Logistics Manager, Emergency Coordinators, Emergency Coordination Team (ECT), Health Manager

### What situations are covered

This document applies to all Sakhalin Energy Assets, Facilities, Operations, Projects and Activities, including activities undertaken by any Contractor on behalf of the Company.

### Requirements

### Asset/ Facilities Managers are Accountable for requirements 1 to 2.

- Ensure that all persons undertaking work on behalf of the Company have access to medical services 1. that take account of the risks associated with the type and location of their work.
- 2. Endeavor to provide medical care for work related injuries and illness that is equivalent to medical care available in the employee's home country.1

#### Emergency Response Coordinators/ Emergency Managers are Responsible for requirements 3.

- 3. Establish and maintain a tiered Medical Emergency Response as part of the overall Emergency Response Plan that includes:
  - First aid treatment, including defibrillation, by a Designated First Aider within 4 minutes.
  - Assessment and stabilization by a medical Emergency professional within one hour.
  - Admission to and care at the nearest Local Hospital within 4 hours.
  - Referral to an appropriate Specialist Hospital (casualty specific).

When response times above cannot be met, perform a Risk Assessment and provide Risk Mitigation measures to verify that the Risks are As Low As Reasonably Practicable (ALARP).

#### Corporate Health Manager is Responsible for requirement 4 to 10

- 4. Carry out Site Medical Reviews.
- 5. Approve Asset MER Manuals.
- 6. Ensure availability of DFA training course for Company employees.
- 7. Manage mobilization of health care professionals of Health Care Service Providers for Company remote assets clinics.
- 8. Support Medevac Procedure.
- Maintain liaison with Health Care Service Institutions (this may be achieved via the Health Care 9. Service Provider), local hospitals, Specialist Hospitals, and Assistance Companies.

<sup>1</sup> This is achieved by provision of personal medical insurance (Shell secondees), medical expense reimbursement (Mitsui secondees), or fixed reimbursement for insurance (expatriate direct hires) in accordance with HR policies and procedures.


