

**APPENDIX 3****International Requirements for Land Management****Purpose**

To specify international standards and other requirements formally adopted by Sakhalin Energy in relation to *Land Management*<sup>1</sup>, in accordance with Russian Federation, Lender and Shareholder requirements.

**Requirements**

Land Management activities shall comply with the provisions of the following internationally recognized standards and conventions (ratified by Russian Federation) and other requirements:

- Sakhalin Energy shall conform with the relevant elements of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Wetland and Waterbody Construction and Mitigation Procedures (2003) and FERC Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation and Maintenance Plan (2003) (note: all those elements to which the Company and its contractors shall comply have been incorporated within the Land Management Standard).
- Ramsar Convention on Wetlands of International Importance, 1987 (with amendments made to the Regineh May 28, 1987).
- Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES), 1979 (amended on December 6, 1979).
- International Plant Protection Convention, Rome, 1997 (The Convention entered into force in 2005).
