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## Cultural Heritage Specification

### Purpose

Minimise negative impact of Sakhalin Energy Project construction activities on Sakhalin *Cultural Heritage*<sup>1</sup> related to all existing and future *Sakhalin Energy Assets, Facilities*, operations, *Projects* activities, including activities undertaken by contractors on behalf of the company and minimise damage to archaeological heritage and ensure public involvement in decisions relating to its protection.

### What situations are covered?

This document applies to all Sakhalin Energy Assets, *Facilities*, operations, *Projects* and Activities, including Activities undertaken by contractors on behalf of the company. Locating and managing Unexploded Ordinance and War Dead are included as part of Sakhalin Energy Security procedures.

### Requirements

**Managers are Accountable for requirements 1 to 6 in their own organisation:**

1. Manage Cultural Heritage in compliance with requirements of Russian Federation law, adopted International Standards related to Cultural Heritage, Lenders and Shareholders.
2. Comply with requirements of International Requirements Specification of the Social Performance Management Standard in regard to Cultural Heritage.
3. Establish, maintain and implement Cultural Heritage Protection Plan<sup>2</sup> in consultation with local archaeological experts.
4. Undertake consultation with local communities and authorities in the event that burial sites are excavated and human remains found, and in the event that Indigenous Peoples' cultural heritage resources are found.
5. Undertake the cultural heritage surveys, mainly identifying archaeological sites, covering areas likely to be affected by the Sakhalin Energy Assets, Facilities, operations, and Projects activities.
6. Archaeological monitoring (field works) shall be conducted by a qualified Cultural Resources Consultant both prior, during and after construction activities: at locations of known/previously identified sites and in areas adjacent to identified sites; and at select locations of high cultural resource sensitivity in the pipeline ROW and the directly impacted areas.
7. Archaeological monitoring (field works) reports shall be prepared and submitted to relevant local Cultural Heritage authorities.
