WHAT IS HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizer is used to decrease infectious agents on hands and to ensure personal hygiene where water and soap are not available.

Alcohol 60-80%

HOW TO CHOOSE A HAND SANITIZER

Not all hand sanitizers kill the coronavirus. Use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol to break down the virus' lipid envelope, just like the soap does.

Sanitizers based on chlorohexidine, triclosan, and miramistin work well against bacteria and germs but cannot affect viruses, therefore they are not recommended for use against coronavirus.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Wash your hands regularly to prevent the spread of the coronavirus. Hand sanitizers can only be used when water and soap are not available.

CAUTION

Frequent use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers may irritate your skin and can cause hand burns if used improperly.

Aromatic compounds and colourants present in the hand sanitizers can also provoke allergic reactions.

HOW TO USE A HAND SANITIZER



Dispense a loonie-size amount of the sanitizer onto the palm.



Rub it thoroughly into your palms, back of your hands and between fingers.



Let the sanitizer dry out completely.
